SUMMARY OF OBSERVATIONS RECORDED AT 08:30 HOURS IST ON DATE: 06.08.2025

REALISED WEATHER: Light to moderate rainfall occurred at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at a few places and extremely heavy at isolated places in Uttarakhand. Monsoon activity remained **VIGOROUS** over the state.

THUNDERSTORM (REPORTED): Dehradun, Mussoorie, Pantnagar, Mukteshwar.

LIGHTNING (BASED ON PRODUCTS): As per lightning products, lightning was observed at a few places in Uttarakhand.

GUSTY WIND (≥ 30 Kmph): (AWS) Pithoragarh_KVK-31, Pantnagar_AMFU-30



Temperatures: Maximum temperatures remained below normal to markedly below normal in plains and below normal to appreciably below normal in hills of Uttarakhand. Minimum temperatures remained normal to below normal in plains and hills of Uttarakhand. Highest maximum temperature **28.3°C** was recorded at **Mohkampur (Dehradun)** and lowest minimum temperature **15.0°C** was recorded at **Mukteshwar (Nainital)**.

SYNOPTIC ANALYSIS

- ❖ The monsoon trough at mean sea level now passes through Ferozepur, Karnal, Moradabad, Kheri, Jalpaiguri and thence northeastwards to the Arunachal Pradesh close to foothills of Himalayas.
- ❖ The trough from central parts of north Uttar Pradesh to northern parts of Kutch across East Rajasthan & north Gujarat persists and now seen between 3.1 & 4.5 km above mean sea level.
- ❖ The upper air cyclonic circulation over Himachal Pradesh & adjoining Uttarakhand at 1.5 km above mean sea level persists.
- ❖ The Western Disturbance as a cyclonic circulation over Punjab & neighborhood at 5.8 km with a trough aloft in middle tropospheric level with its axis at 7.6 km above mean sea level runs roughly along Long. 73°E to north of 32°N persists.

DAMAGE AND MEDIA REPORTS: As per SEOC reports:

1. Many people have been reported missing, and several hotels and homes have been damaged in Dharali market, Bhatwari, Uttarkashi, due to rising water levels in Kheerganga river, caused by heavy rains.
2. Two women were reportedly trapped under the debris of a house that collapsed due to heavy rains in village Buransi, district Pauri Garhwal.
3. Three livestock were reportedly swept away by the heavy rain in village Bungidhar, Thailisain, Pauri Garhwal.
